- Nigeria has overtaken South Africa's economy and is now the biggest business and investment hub in Africa having of population 175 million with people increasing disposable income.
- Nigeria's healthcare market was valued at \$18billion in 2013 and \$20billion in 2014, of which 17% constitutes oral healthcare.
- Oral healthcare saw a positive performance in 2013, with value growth of 12% and an expected 15-18% growth year after year.
- There is an increased awareness across Nigeria on the benefits of regular usage of oral care products, treatments for dental diseases, and significant demand for cosmetics dentistry.
- In 2013, mandatory dental examinations were implemented across Nigeria for individuals undergoing medical check-ups. This has increased the demand for the establishment of dental facilities, clinics and institutions throughout the country.

The launch of Dental Africa Exhibition & Congress concluded at the Eko Hotel & Exhibition Centre with record breaking success. Dental Africa Exhibition & Congress accommodated over 28 exhibiting companies from over 15 countries showcasing the very latest breakthroughs and technological developments in Dentistry.
